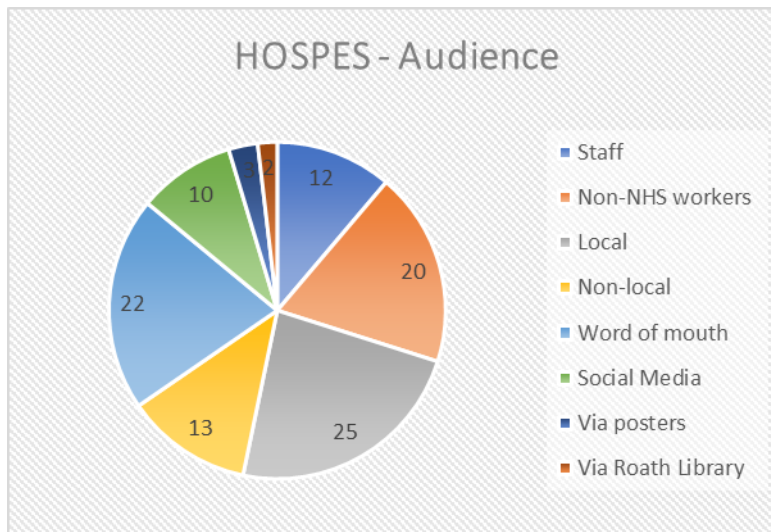
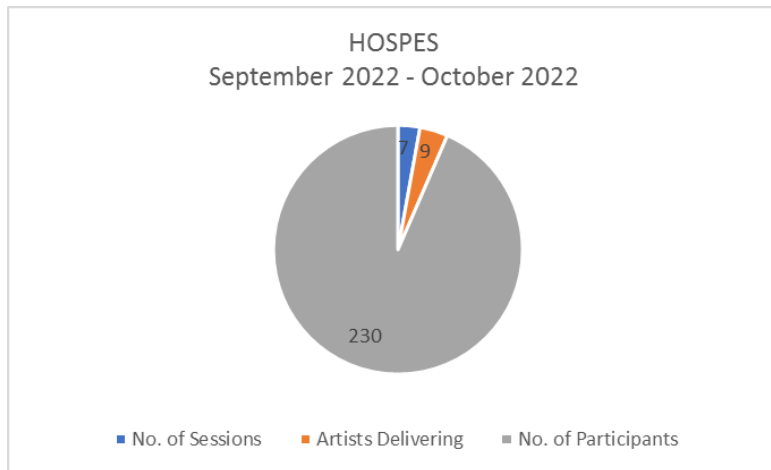


Installation Evaluation Data - Hospes

HOSPES Sound and Film Installation and Online Portal 17/10/22 to 25/10/22 at Capel I Bawb, Cardiff Royal Infirmary

In total 230 people visited the Installation at the renovated Chapel. The following information was collected from visitors.

Up to 25/10/22 there were 274 visits to the Cardiff Royal Infirmary Arts Webpage Hospes article, 205 likes and 66 shares on social media to 25/10/22.



- 42 people responded with written evaluation:

Raising Awareness of multi-cultural communities:

100% of people surveyed agreed that they had an increased awareness and understanding of the local community through experiencing the installation

Themes from Written Comments in relation to the Installation:

Pride in their multi-cultural community 21%

Positive sense of community 14%

New understanding of how CRI impacts on community 10%

Positive reaction to the venue within the community 34%

Positive reaction to the diversity within Cardiff 24%

Other comments included:

A realisation of the warmth and humour of Cardiff depicted in the installation
The Varied stories from the participants and Interviewees
The gratitude to Wales and Cardiff expressed

Hospes Installation

On a scale of 1-10, poor-excellent:

62% rated 10

19% rated 9

14% rated 8

4% rated 7

This information together with the verbal responses from visitors to the exhibition and the artwork itself as evidence confirmed positive outcomes and achievement in relation to the following project aims:

- raise awareness of our multi-cultural communities in Cardiff
- Give those communities a voice
- Create connections with communities
- Communicate the connection of the CRI to our communities
- Create an artwork which shone in its own unique way as a signature project artwork
